Aarsleff Ground Engineering Ltd cares about the Occupational Health, Safety & Wellbeing of all employees and others who may be affected by our undertakings, and recognises that Occupational Health, Safety & Wellbeing (OHSW) is an integral and fundamental part of our business and our #Step Into The Blue (#SITB) culture.

In line with our other company procedures and policies we have assessed the risk of hazards which could and have resulted in eye injury and decided to implement a Mandatory Safety Eyewear Policy from January 2022.

We commit to:

- Providing safety protective and prescription safety eyewear or over glasses free of charge to all our employees and where necessary others who may be affected, in accordance with our IMS procedures.
- Providing information instruction and training on the hazards to which our employees and others who may be affected are exposed.
- Providing information, instruction and training on the Use, Care and Maintenance of safety eyewear.
- Regular monitoring of compliance with this policy through competent supervision and management.
- Providing a selection of suitable safety eyewear to cover different hazards, tasks and individuals

Senior Management are responsible for implementing the Company's policy, although it is recognised the true effectiveness of this policy depends on the full co-operation and participation of all employees and as such their commitment to the content of the policy is encouraged.

The contents of this policy and all revisions which may be made will be brought to the notice of all employees.

This policy will form part of the Integrated Management System and be formally reviewed annually by Senior Management.
