- Diagnosing and resolving mechanical faults efficiently
- Ensuring equipment is safe and operational

Support both workshop-based and on-site activities, including:

- Site visits
- Remote working assignments
- Periods away from home when required for training or project work
- Follow all health & safety procedures, ensuring compliance with company policies and industry regulations
- Maintain accurate records of work completed and training progress
- Take responsibility for personal learning and development throughout the apprenticeship
